

Read Me First

These studies are free of charge.

Most of these studies are for children ages 8 – 12 although they can be used with younger children and some have been used with adults.

If you are going to use these lessons as a teacher you **MUST** work through the information **FIRST** or face being unprepared.

Some of these lessons are going to contain minor errors due to poor proof reading on my part which is another good reason to work through them before you use them.

You may think some of these lessons to hard for your guys but if you will be patient you will see they are not.

How I use these lessons.

1. We sit in a class room with me sitting at the head.
2. We use “bible bucks” as an incentive to the students to participate.
3. “If” there is a decoder on the front page we do that first. If not we go straight to the lesson.
4. Each child is called upon to read a paragraph going clock wise around the room until the lesson is read. There will be plenty of opportunity for you to pause them and enforce points or ask them questions about what they are reading.
5. After the lesson is read if there is a question and answer session we do that next but if not choose one of the lesson related games i.e. cross word to do next.
6. After that follow up with a maze or dot to dot or something lighter then go back to one of the lesson related games.
7. The point is to keep changing what they are doing to keep their interest and participation high. You can do 5 or 6 varied things on the same topic and hold their attention longer than doing 1 or 2 long things.
8. We close in prayer with each child praying again in clockwise formation.
