Play: Dare To Be A Daniel Part ONE

Actors: Narrator, Nebuchadnezzar, Ashpenaz, Melzar, Daniel, Jeremiah and God.

<u>Narrator</u>: In the 3rd year of the rule of Jehoiakim King of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon who laid siege to Jerusalem.

God: Jeremiah, go tell the children of Israel that very soon I will punish them because they have not kept my commandments as they promised to do.

Jeremiah: OK LORD, I will do so.

Narrator: Jeremiah warned the Hebrews but they did not believe he would punish them. They continued to break the commandments which they greed to follow.

Narrator: God decided to use Nebuchadnezzar as his tool to punish Israel.

Ashpenaz: Prince Nebuchadnezzar Pharaohnechoh is attacking our city.

<u>Nebuchadnezzar</u>: Very well, get my armor and I will go before my father King Nabopolassar.

<u>Narrator</u>: Nebuchadnezzar goes before his father to get permission to attack the Egyptians and Pharaohnechoh. Permission is granted and Nebuchadnezzar goes to war against the Egyptians. The Egyptians were defeated in 606 B.C. at the famous battle of Carchemish.

<u>Nebuchadnezzar</u>: Ashpenaz we will have a great victory against these Egyptians in our next battle. They cannot defeat us.

<u>Ashpenaz</u>: The battle of the city of Carchemish will be remembered for thousands of years general!

<u>Nebuchadnezzar</u>: When we finish with the Egyptians we may as well capture the Hebrews in Jerusalem on our way home. They have been on my mind for some strange reason.

Ashpenaz: Rumor has it general that they have made a contract with the God of heaven and have not kept it.

Narrator: After the battle of Carchemish the Babylonians laid siege to Jerusalem.

Ashpenaz: General Nebuchadnezzar I have bad news and good news for you.

Nebuchadnezzar: What is it Ashpenaz?

<u>Ashpenaz</u>: The bad news is this. Your father King Nabopolassar has died. However the good news is that you are now King of Babylon!

<u>Narrator</u>: Nebuchadnezzar goes back to Babylonian to set up his government now that he was king over all the known world. He also gave orders to Ashpenaz concerning Jerusalem.

<u>Nebuchadnezzar</u>: Ashpenaz I will need some good Hebrew people we can train to help us rule over the rest of the Hebrews. Go to Jerusalem and bring back some of their children. Don't just get any children but get the best you can find.

<u>Ashpenaz</u>: Right King! <u>Smart, obedient, healthy</u> and <u>young</u> enough to change their thinking. We will have to change their <u>food</u>, <u>language</u>, <u>dress</u>, <u>customs</u>, their <u>God</u> and their names as well.

Nebuchadnezzar: Make it so!

<u>Narrator</u>: Ashpenaz collects the best of the Hebrew children and brings them back to Babylon to be trained. This training was designed to cause them to lose their identity.

Ashpenaz: You boy! What is your name and how old are you?

Daniel: My name is Daniel and I am 11 years old. My name means "God is judge".

<u>Ashpenaz</u>: Your new name is Belteshazzar. This name means "Prince of Bel. Bel is the name of our god and you will learn to serve him. We will change your name, your clothes, your food, your language, your customs and your gods. You will serve King Nebuchadnezzar, King of Babylon. King of the whole earth.

Narrator: But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not let the Babylonians change who he was and he would never forget the God of Israel or his laws.

<u>Ashpenaz</u>: Melzar as prince of the eunuchs it is your job to retrain these children. They are to becomes servants to Nebuchadnezzar. Therefore use whatever means necessary to change their identity.

Melzar: As you wish my Lord! I will change them into perfect little Babylonians.

<u>Narrator</u>: The Bible says God brought Daniel into favor with Melzar because Daniel had purposed in his heart not to become a Babylonian.

<u>Daniel</u>: Please understand Melzar we cannot eat some of your foods because of the law of our God.

<u>Melzar</u>: Daniel if you and your friends do not eat then you will become sick. If you become sick the King will remove my precious head from my precious body. So you see my friend, you must eat!

Daniel: Let's have a contest Melzar.

<u>Melzar</u>: Contest! We are talking about my head here. There is no contest where my head is concerned!

<u>Daniel</u>: You will not lose your head Melzar. Just allow me and my friends to eat nothing but vegetables for ten days.

<u>Narrator</u>: When we purpose in our hearts to do what is right God will always be there to help us. This is true in every dispensation.
