Do Right Daniel Gets Into Trouble Again!!

P1 Sometimes it seems like no matter what you do you get into trouble, even when you are doing right you can end up with people getting mad at you. But always remember this: God is always on your side when you are doing right and he will make sure that you get rewarded for doing right.

P2 In our story today Daniel gets into trouble just for doing right.... Again. But he does not stop doing right because he knows the God of all creation is on his side.

P3 Then new king sets up a new government over Babylon. Dan 6:1 It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom an hundred and twenty princes, which should be over the whole kingdom; 2 And over these three presidents; of whom Daniel was first: that the princes might give accounts unto them, and the king should have no damage.

P4 Dan 6:3 Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.

P5 Dan 6:4 Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he was faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him. Bad people are always looking to make good people look bad so the bad people will look good. You cannot expect sinners or lost people to act like believers.

P6 Hmmmm if Daniel is so good we will have to make a plan that will use his goodness against him. Dan 6:5 Then said these men, We shall not find any occasion against this Daniel, except we find it against him concerning the law of his God.

P7 Dan 6:6 Then these presidents and princes assembled together to the king, and said thus unto him, King Darius, live for ever. Question... do you think they really wanted Darius to live forever?

P8 Dan 6:7 All the presidents of the kingdom, the governors, and the princes, the counsellors, and the captains, have consulted together to establish a royal statute, and to make a firm decree, that whosoever shall ask a petition^{request} of any God or man for thirty days, save of thee, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions.

P9 Now what are they doing here? They know that Daniel prays 3 times a day. They know that Daniel is requesting the freedom of Israel when he prays. So they hatch a plan to get Dan killed for doing right. Who are these guys? We have seen them all before. They want Daniels job but Daniel is so good and faithful that all the kings of Babylon have trusted him.

P10 So they use the pride of the King to set a trap for Daniel. By the way... what is the first word in Daniel 6:7? Did ALL the presidents consult together? What president was left out??

P11 So these bad men ask the king to make a law that says: NO ONE can make a request of anyone for 30 days except the king. This makes the king more important than anyone else for in the creation for 30 days. But it also will get Daniel into trouble because he will not follow a law that prevents him from praying to God.

P12 Dan 6:8 Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not. This means that once the king made a law it could not be changed!!! So be careful Mr. King!

P13 Oops! To late! Dan 6:9 Wherefore king Darius signed the writing and the decree.

P14 Dan 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

P15 Notice Daniels attitude. He is not worried. He is not afraid. He is not ashamed of God. If a law was mad tomorrow that said: No More Praying! What would you do? Would you dare to be a Daniel? Would you dare to stand alone? I hope you would.

P16 Dan 6:11 Then these men ^{bad men} assembled, and found ^{spied on} Daniel praying and making supplication ^{request or petition} before his God.

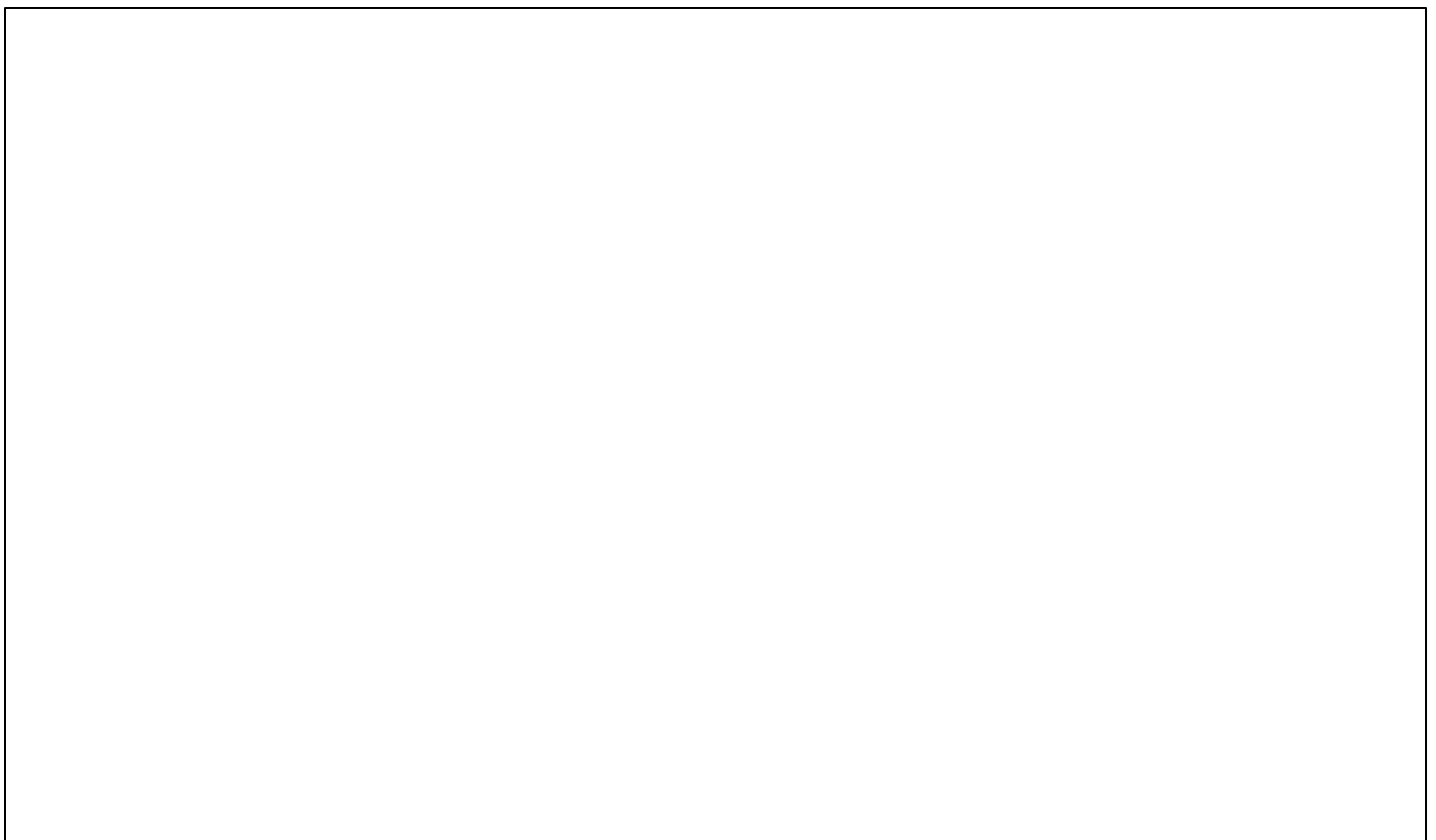
P17 Dan 6:12 Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree; Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask a petition of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing is true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.

P18 Dan 6:13 Then answered they and said before the king, **That Daniel**, which is of the children of the captivity of Judah, regardeth not thee, O king, nor the decree that thou hast signed, but maketh his petition three times a day.

P19 Dan 6:14 Then the king, when he heard these words, was sore displeased with himself, and set his heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

P20 Has the king made a dreadful mistake? Will he be able to save Daniel? What will happen to the evil men? Find out next week.....
