### Attributes of God Exodus 34:6

God has many holy, glorious attributes. They are not all listed in one place in scripture, but scattered throughout, a little here and a little there, as described in Is 28:10. We will only be looking at four of them today: God as our Father, our Comforter, and His all forgiving and faithful nature.

In Exodus 33:17-34:6, we read the story of Moses asking the Lord if he could see Him, and God's reply. In 33:18 Moses says to God *shew me thy glory* and God replies in v19 *I will make all my goodness pass before thee.* His goodness, an attribute, a character trait, is his glory. In v20 God says *Thou canst not see my face,* v22 *while my glory passeth by,* v23 but you can see my back. His presence, seeing Him, even His back, is seeing His goodness and his glory. By seeing His attributes we see His glory.

Exodus 34:5-6 says, And the LORD descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth,

The Lord passed by Moses and proclaimed His attributes as His glory.
