Nebby Learns To Be Humble Before God

P1 Have you ever been humble? What does it mean to be humble? The word is a wisdom word because first you learn about it and then you practice it. The word humble means: to show respect and esteem due a superior or an elder. Superior means someone who is over you, like a parent and elder means older than you. Esteem means to value.

P2 Nebby had lost his esteem for God. He had forgotten God. God was Nebby's superior. Everything that Nebby had came from God. He had no reason to be proud but he had every reason to be thankful.

P3 In our story today Nebby gets a wake up call. God reminds Nebby to be humble and thankful to the God of heaven.

P4 Dan 4:30 The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the house of the kingdom by the might of my power, and for the honour of my majesty?

P5 Dan 4:31 While the word was in the king's mouth, there fell ^{came} a voice from heaven, saying, O king Nebuchadnezzar, to thee it is spoken; The kingdom is departed ^{taken} from thee.

P6 Dan 4:32 And they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field: they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and seven times ^{years} shall pass over thee, until thou know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.

P7 Dan 4:33 The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' feathers, and his nails like birds' claws.

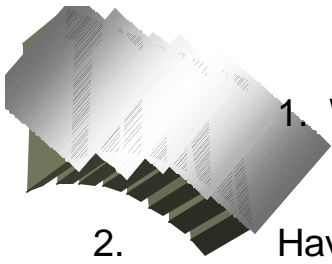
P8 Dan 4:34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom is from generation to generation:

P9 Dan 4:35 And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed ^{counted} as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay ^{stop} his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou? ^{Nobody tells God what to do.}

P10 Dan 4:36 At the same time my reason returned unto me; and for the glory of my kingdom, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me; and I was established in my kingdom, and excellent majesty was added unto me.

P11 Dan 4:37 Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol ^{praise highly} and honour the King of heaven, all whose works are truth, and his ways judgment ^{right}: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase ^{humble or bring low}.

P12 A good verse to learn with this true story is : Prov 13:10a Only by pride cometh contention ^{active quarreling or conflict}

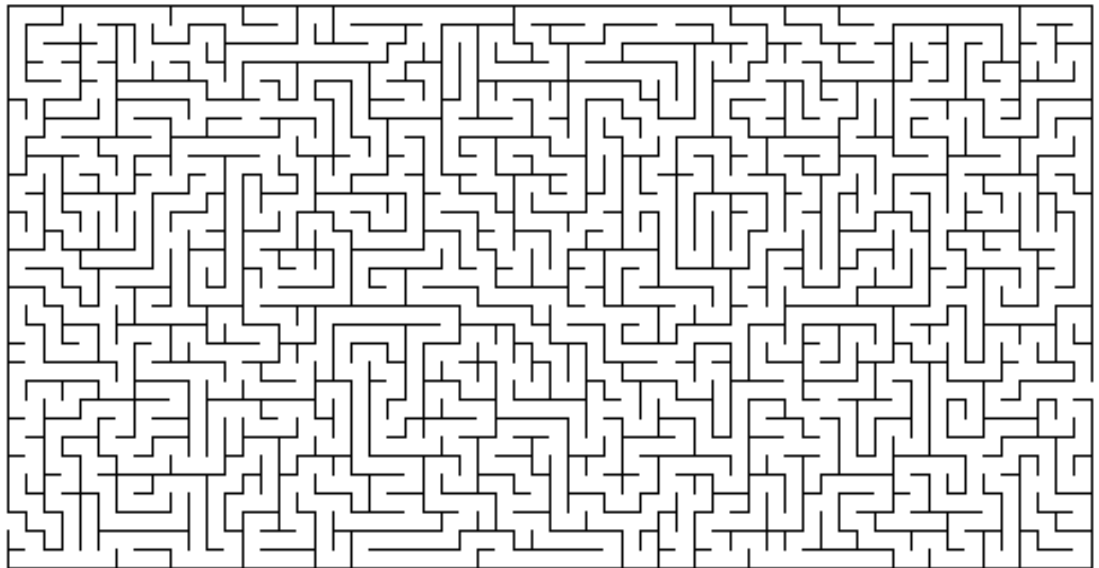
